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Genesis 4:1-3 | Cain & Abel

[1] Now Adam knew Eve his wife, and she conceived and bore Cain, saying, "I have gotten a man with the help of the LORD." [2] And again, she bore his brother Abel. Now Abel was a keeper of sheep, and Cain a worker of the ground.

ABEL WAS A KEEPER OF SHEEP • Sheep in Heb. = A smaller flock, portion, inheritance Second born son tending God's "flocks"

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Genesis 4:1-3 | Cain & Abel

- CAIN, A WORKER OF THE GROUND
 - - the ground (Gen. 2:5)
 - Eden to *work it and keep it*. (Gen. 2:15)
 - "husband" Gods creation.

When no bush of the field was yet in the land and no small

plant of the field had yet sprung up—for the LORD God had not

caused it to rain on the land, and *there was no man to work*

• The firstborn Cain is operating in humanity's divine mandate

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Genesis 4:3-5 | Cain & Abel

[3] In the course of time Cain brought to the LORD an offering of the fruit of the ground, [4] and Abel also brought of the firstborn of his flock and of their fat portions. And the LORD had regard for Abel and his offering [5] but for Cain and his offering he had no regard. So Cain was very angry, and his face fell.

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Genesis 4:6-7 | Cain & Abel

[6] The LORD said to Cain, "Why are you angry, and why has your face fallen? [7] If you do well, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well, sin is crouching at the door. Its desire is contrary to you, but you must rule over it."

ABEL SPIRIT

- Steward your portion with devotion to the provider
- Give the best and first portion of your inheritance

CAIN SPIRIT

- Abdicates mandate to husband creation
- Entitled the best for himself

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Desire & Sin | Cain & Abel Spirits

UNRULY DESIRE

- Lustful, instinctual desires
- Children and their tantrums
- people's behavior

SIN & MISSING THE MARK

- What we aim at determines what we see
- Goal guided behavior charts a course to the "end"
- The Glory we've been created to exhibit Rom. 3:23

If you cannot order your internal world you must control other

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Sacrifice | Cain & Abel Spirits

SACRIFICE IS AN EXERCISE IN MASTERING DESIRE

- Give up what is most valuable now for a future gain
- Trains us in delayed gratification
- Forces us to honor the reality of the community of "self"
 - The present, past and future "self"
- Keeps the goal/aim ever before us

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Genesis 4:8-10 | Cain & Abel

[8] Cain spoke to Abel his brother. And when they were in the *field*, Cain rose up against his brother Abel and killed him. [9] Then the LORD said to Cain, "Where is Abel your brother?" He said, "I do not know; am I my brother's keeper?" [10] And the LORD said, "What have you done? The voice of your brother's **blood is crying to me** from the ground.

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Murder | Origin of Violence

CAINS RESPONSE | TWO CHOICES

- eternal standard.

1. Submit to God's standard. Heed the call to become more than we already are and grow into His promises for us. 2. Murder the earthly representation that holds us to the God's

• The origin of human violence is a refusal to grow spiritually You can either grow spiritually or decimate God's standards

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Decimation = Latin for execute a 10^{Th}



FRATRACIDE

- Marked for death by the ruling power for disobedience and/or desertion
- Random / arbitrary selection
- Sentence carried out by our "brothers"
- Cain & Abel in culture

GENDER CONFUSION RACISM SILENCE IS VIOLENCE

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 Original meaning was about gendered nouns referring to self evident biological sex

No longer about skin color but about power

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John 15:3-6 | Solution

you abide in me. [5] I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that **bears much** the branches are gathered, thrown into the fire, and burned.

[3] Already you are clean because of the word that I have spoken to you. [4] Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot **bear** *fruit* by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless *fruit*, for apart from me you can do nothing. [6] If anyone does not abide in me he is thrown away like a branch and withers; and

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John 15:7-8 | *Solution*

[7] If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. [8] By this my Father is glorified, that you **bear much fruit** and so prove to be my disciples. [9] As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Abide in my love.

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
